

Our primary focus is on pediatric care; however we provide services to individuals with special needs of all ages as well as women's health.

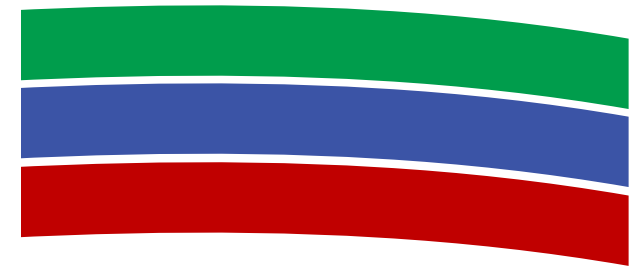

SPEECH THERAPY

A speech therapist focuses on developing or enhancing an individual's language skills, which may be delayed from birth. The speech therapist may focus on the following:

- Speech intelligibility
- Stuttering
- Receptive and expressive language
- Swallowing
- Memory
- Auditory comprehension
- Reading comprehension
- Non-verbal communication
- Sign language
- Augmentative/alternative communication
- Oral motor deficits

OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

An occupational therapist assists with development of upper extremity functioning in order for an individual to attain optimal independent functioning. Occupational therapy focuses on using age related functional tasks as a way to regain function.

This may include the following:

- Upper extremity strengthening
- Coordination skills
- Eye-hand coordination
- Visual perceptual skills
- Play skills
- Sensory Integration
- Adaptive equipment
- ADL's (e.g., dressing, grooming, hygiene, self feeding, cooking, money management and community integration)
- Wheelchair positioning
- Behavior modification
- Neuromuscular re-education

PHYSICAL THERAPY

A physical therapist assists with the development of motor control. Physical therapy focuses on posture and mobility to enable an individual to progress through age-related changes. This may include the following:

- Basic mobility (e.g., rolling, crawling, sitting, standing, and walking)
- Balance and coordination
- Lower extremity functioning and strength
- Lower extremity contractures and positioning
- Strengthening and endurance activities
- Adaptive equipment such as bracing systems, walkers, wheelchairs, etc.
- Neuromuscular re-education
